WHEREAS we , Sue Moore, Edith Moore Stewart and Correne Moore Sloat,

well and truly indebted to

W.G.Sirrine

in the full and just sum of Three thousand two hundred five 18/100

Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

in installments of \$60.00 per month due and payable on the 15th day of each calendar month, beginning March 15th, 1950, balance due four years from date, payments to be applied first to interest, balance to principal, with the privilege to anticipate payment, part or all, at any time after after six months from the date hereof,

with interest from date at the rate of six per centum per annum semi-annually in advance until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Sue Moore, Edith Moore Stewart and Correne Moore Sloan in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. G.Sirrine, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Town-ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the North side of Mahon Street and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 13 and 14 of Block C of Park Place, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A, Page 119, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stake on the northern side of Mahon Street, at the corner of a 10-foot alley and running thence along the northern side of Mahon Street, S. 89-45 E. 100 feet to a stake, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, N. 0-17 E. 111 feet to a stake on another 10-foot alley; thence along the south side of said alley, N. 63-45 W. 114.8 feet to a stake on the southern corner of the intersection of the last mentioned alley with the first mentioned alley; thence along the first mentioned alley, S. 0-17 W. 167 feet to the beginning corner.

The above two lots were conveyed to C. F. Moore by two separate deeds, Lot No. 13 being conveyed to him by deed recorded in Deed Book 182, Page 62, R. M.C. Office for Treenville County, S. C., and Lot No. 14, by deed recorded in Deed Book 196, Page 314, R. M.C. Office for Greenville County. The said C.F. Moore subsequently died on April 1, 1938, leaving as his sole heirs and distributees his widow, Sue Moore and three children, Hubert, Edith and Correne Moore, all of whom are now more than 21 years of age. Edith Moore is now Edith Moore Stewart.
