NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fair View

Township, containing one and six one hundredths (1.06) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Cox Street, about 250 feet outside the town limits of Simpsonville, and running along said street South 842 East for 116 feet to an iron pin; thence South 12 West for 370 feet to an iron pin on a new street; thence South 752 West along said new street for 120 feet to an iron pin; thence North 12 East for 422 feet along a side street to the beginning point; and being shown and designated as Lots No. 6 and 8 on a plat made by E.
