NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western side of Oakview Drive, in the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 1 on Plat of property of Harold C. Gibson, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, in December 1949, recorded in Plat Book X at Page 73 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Oakview Drive, and running thence N. 47-33 W. 173 feet to a stake; thence S. 21-23 W. 190 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 2; thence with the line of said lot, S. 68-37 E. 160 feet to a stake on Oakview Drive; thence with the Western side of Oakview Drive, N. 13-08 E. 84.2 feet to a stake; thence continuing with said Drive, N. 38-46 E. 47.5 feet to the beginning corner."
