Trustee under the B. M. McGee Trust Deed, his successors and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Green-ville County, State of South Carolina, containing 15.47 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as Tract No. 5, according to Plat of the property of the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank known as the C.R. Bramlett farm, which plat was made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, on March 23, 1937, and being more particularly described according to said Plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of J. H. Southern, which iron pin is in a branch, and running thence N. 74 E. 500 feet to iron pin (this course is partially along another branch); thence S. 25-27 E. 307 feet to iron pin in center of road to Airport; thence along center of said road, N. 67 E. 403 feet to iron pin in said road, and in corner of Tract No. 4; thence with said Tract, N. 19-10 W. 887 feet to iron pin in line of property of R.
