TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Willard E. Dixon

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Sixteen Hundred Thirty and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 1630.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the Northwestern side of Augusta Road, South of the City of Greenville, being tract No. 3 of property of Ladson A. Mills, as shown on plat made by Dalton & Neves, Eng.; August 1925, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at Page 62 and containing 5.02 acres, more or less, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on the Northwestern side of Augusta Road, 733.9 feet Southwest of the intersection of a road that runs by the Woodside Peace, and bounds tract No. 4, also at corner of tract No. 2, and running thence with line of tract No. 2, N. 45-58 W. 820.8 feet to pipe, corner of land now or formerly owned by Annis M. Moon; thence N. 75-50 E. 352.2 feet to pin, corner of tract No. 4; thence with line of tract No. 4, S. 46 E. 637 feet to iron pin on Augusta Road; thence along the Northwestern side of Augusta Road, S. 44-09 W. 300 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Volume 201 at Page 417."
