To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Elizabeth L. Smith and Eva R. McGowan ————— SEND GREETING.

Whereas, we, the said Elizabeth L. Smith and Eva R. McGowan in and by our certain joint promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted to Mrs. C. C. McGowan

in the full and just sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars,

to be paid at the rate of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per month; the first payment to be made on February 1, 1952, and successive payments made on the 1st day of each successive month thereafter.

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings; then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage, as a part of said debt.
