WHEREAS I Jane S. Wendlinger,

am well and truly indebted to

The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee for Greenville News-Piedmont Company Employees' Trust,

in the full and just sum of Seventy-Three Hundred Fifty & 00/100 (\$7,350.00) Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

\$300.00 on principal each three (3) months after date, with the balance to be paid May 2, 1958,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee for Greenville News-Piedmont Company Employees' Trust, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the East side of Williams Street and on the South side of an alley, and being a part of Lot No. 4, Block 7, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book A, pages 90-91, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Williams Street, at corner of lot of C. S. Allen, and thence with his line N. 66-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15 W. 66 feet to iron pin on 15 foot alley; thence along said alley S. 66-30 W. 150 feet to iron pin on Williams Street; thence along said Street S 15 E. 66 feet to beginning.
