MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, William A. Greer,

hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor, SEND(S) GREETING.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The Peoples National Bank, as Trustee, under agreement with Joseph C. Newell (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of \$12,250.00, plus interest.

Fifty and 16/100 -

DOLLARS (\$12,250.00)

with interest thereon from date of the note at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$130.00 on February 25, 1952, and a like payment of \$130.00 on the 25th day of each successive month thereafter until paid in full. Said payments to be applied to interest, balance to principal, with interest thereon from date of note at the rate of Five-(5%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN: That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, In Section Twenty-four, being the Southeast side of Tract No. 3 and 20 feet or the Northwest side of Tract No. 2, as shown on a plat of the property of Julia D. Charles made by W. A. Middle, April 1936, and described as follows:

"Beginning at an iron in on South side of White Horse Road, a line in 14 feet east, approximately S. 41-36 E., of corner of tract No. 4, and running thence S. 33-20-11, 796.5 feet, more or less, to a 10 foot road, which point is 97.6 feet S. 05-15 E., from line of tract No. 4; thence with said 10-foot road, S. 05-15 E., 7.6 feet to thence S. 31-20 E., 716.8 feet to an iron pin on White-horse road; thence with White-horse Road, N. 41-48 W., 101 feet to the point of beginning."

Being the same premises aforesaid conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Volume 285 at page 433.

The note which this mortgage is given to secure is also secured by the pledge and deposit of certain shares of the capital stock of Textro Chemicals, Inc.
