All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the west side of Buncombe Road, and being known and designated as the greater portion of lot No. 10, of Block A, of the Mt. View Land Company, as shown by plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat book A, pages 396, and 397, and having the following description:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of the Buncombe Road, joint corner of Lots 9 and 10, and running thence along the joint line of said lots 180 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence along the line of said alley in a northwesterly direction 37.9 feet to a stake at corner of lot belonging to C.
