Pall that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township, on the Northeast side of Crestline Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 18, Block "A", on a plat of Hillandale Heights, made by T. M. Welborn, Surveyor, October 7, 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Y", Page 113, and said lot being bounded on the Northeast by lands of Moseley; on the Southeast by Lot No. 19 of said survey; on the Southwest by Crestline Road; and on the Northwest by Lot No. 17 of said survey; the within described lot fronts on Crestline Road for 100 feet, extends back therefrom on each side for 200 feet, and is 100 feet in the rear."
