All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town-ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 33 of South Cherokee Park, as shown on Plat thereof recorded in Plat Book A at Page 130, and being more particularly described, according to said Plat, as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southeast corner of Keowee Avenue and Elsie Street (formerly Saluda Street) and running thence with Elsie Street, S. 63 E. 172 feet, more or less, to an alley; thence along said alley, S. 27 W. 70 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 32; thence with said lot, N. 63 W. 172 feet, more or less, to a stake on Keowee Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 27 E. 70 feet to the beginning.
