C. Jones, C. E., December, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, at page 84, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western edge of Stokes Street, the joint front corner of Lots 30 and 31, and running thence along the western edge of Stokes Street, N. 3-07 W. 66.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the western edge of Stokes Street, the chord of which is N. 15-26 W. 53.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the western edge of Stokes Street, the chord of which is N. 37-19 W. 40.9 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 39-52 W. 128.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-35 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 30 and 31; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 85-11 E. 152.6 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being a portion of the property conveyed to mortgagor corporation by Louise Earle and India E. Pepper by deed dated September 25, 1952 and recorded in the R. M.
