C. and the state of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgager, in monthly installments of Fifty-six and Dollars (\$ 56.02 two one-hundreths), commencing on the first day of February , 1954, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of January , 19 74 .

Now, Knew And Man; that Mortgager, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgager, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgager at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgager, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina;

All that certain piece, parcel or let of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, at the southwest corner of Lenore Avenue and Earnshaw Avenue, being known and lesignated as Lot No. 138 of the Sans Souch Heights subdivision, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book Y page 145 and having according to a recent survey made by James H. Beeson November 25, 1953 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Harnshaw Avenue and Lenore Avenue, and running thence with the southwest side of Earnshaw Avenue S. 34-17 E. 174.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-32 W. 11.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 68-54 W. 94 feet to an iron pin rear corner of lot No. 139; thence with the line of said lot N. 22-49 W. 170.9 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Lenore Avenue; thence with the south side of said Avenue H. 67-11 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
