TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, W.E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

FOURTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$ 1,400.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, lying near the Reid School, lying on the North side of a Road that leads from the Meece Bridge Road to the Sandy Flat Road, bounded on the North by lands of Mrs. James Batson, on the East by Theron Dill, on the South by other lands of mortgagors, and on the West by Mrs. James Batson, having the following courses and distances, to wit: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the road, corner with Theron Dill lot, and runs thence with line of that lot N. 10.31 W. 340 feet to an iron pin, corner with Dill and Mrs. James Batson; thence with Batson line S. 74.30 W. 525.5 feet to an iron pin, Batson corner; thence continuing with Batson line S.14.30 E. 355 feet to an iron pin on road; thence along the road N. 72.41 E. 503 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of that tract of land conveyed to the grantors by T.H. Strickland on August 1, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 439, at page 376, containing 4.1 acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
