All that lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lots Nos. 3, 4, and 5 according to a plat of the Bankrupt property of ". H. Irvine, said plat being recorded in Plat Book "E", at page 284. This property includes Lot No. 2, according to a plat of the property of James F. Foster recorded in Plat Book "F", at page 69. The said property is a portion of the land conveyed to James F. Foster by Israel Chapel, colored Methodist Church, by deed recorded in Vol 89, page 126 and of the property conveyed to James F. Foster by Eva B. Irvine, et al, by deed recorded in Vol. 102, page 205, and the same property conveyed by James F. Foster to Sallie E. Foster by deed recorded in Vol. 224, page 41. All of these references are to records in the Greenville County R.M.C. office.
