I, EVELYN OWEN MIMS FORD

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Evelyn Owen Mims Ford  
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Harris Ford  
in the full and just sum of Fifty-Five Hundred and No One Hundredths Dollars,  
(\$5500.00), to be paid Three years from date,

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid Semi-Annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage  
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises  
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to  
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harris  
Ford, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
near the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the northern  
side of the East North Street, Eastern side of Glover Street.

BEGINNING at the Northeast corner of North and Glover Streets running  
thence with North Street, N. 76-45 E. 54.5 ft. to a pin on said Street;  
thence N. 21-28 W. 38.8 ft. to a pin at the end of a wall; thence N.  
20-33 W. 97 ft. to corner of garage; thence N. 21-24 W. 44.2 ft. to pin  
in line of fence; thence S. 76-45 W. 6.3 ft. to a pin; thence N. 21-25  
W. 4.9 ft. to a pin; thence S. 76-45 W. 51 ft. to an iron fence post on  
Glover Street; thence with Glover Street S. 21-45 E. 185 ft. to the  
beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to E. C. Goddard, Sr.,  
and Lucie Goddard Steadman by Martha C. Goddard, deed dated September  
30, 1926, recorded in the R. M. C. Office, said Greenville County in  
Deed Book 104 at page 258, excepting, however, a strip conveyed to Al-  
bert J. Hobbs cut from this lot confronting North Street 5.5 ft. and  
running back the length of said lot, the width in the rear being 3 ft.
