at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ruth C. Aiken, her heirs and assigns forever, the fifty feet rear portion of Lots Nos. 88,89, and 90 located in Greenville County, South Carolina, near the intersection of Orlando Avenue and Lakeland Avenue (Furman Hall Road), the original plat of Paris-Piney Park, made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, dated June, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at page 19, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin 101.1 feet from the intersection of Orlando Avenue and Lakeland Avenue (Furman Hall Road) on the Western side of said Lakeland Avenue (Furman Hall Road) and running thence N. 55-30 W. to the common line of Lots 89 and 90; running thence N. 55-30 W. 50 feet to the common line of Lots 88 and 89; then running N. 55-30 W. 50 feet to the common line of Lots 87 and 88; thence S. 34-30 W 50 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots 87 and 88; thence S. 55-30 E. 50 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 88 and 89; thence S. 55-30 E. 50 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 89 and 90; thence S. 55-30 E. 44.1 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Lakeland Avenue (Furman Hall Road); thence with Lakeland Avenue (Furman Hall Road)in a Northerly direction 50 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
