whereas, there remains unpaid on a certain note and mortgage given by Margaret C. WHEREAS, Margaret C. Hammond is still the owner of the premises covered by the above mentioned mortgage; and

WHEREAS, the said Margaret C. Hammond has requested that Liberty Life Insurance Company extend the time of payment of said note as hereinafter provided, which said Liberty Life Insurance Company has consented and agreed to do;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, Margaret C.
