Court of said state, at chambers or otherwise, or to any Judge of the County Court in any county which has a county court, for the appointment of a receiver, with authority to take possession of said premises and collect said rents and profits, applying the said profits (after paying the cost of collection) upon said debt, interest, cost and expenses without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.

In the event foreclosure of the premises hereinabove described is instituted the mortgagor(s) herein expressly waives (or waive) the benefit of any and all appraisement laws under the Statutes of the State of South Carolina.
