"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all'improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying at the northwestern intersection of Georgia Avenue and Easley Bridge Road, shown on a plat entitled "Property of H. W. Brockman and W. R. Scarborough" recorded in Plat Book Y at page 62 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, being further described, according to said plat, as follows:
