"ALL that certain piece, percel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, tying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, about Il miles from the City of Greenville, on the West side of the road from Simpsonville to Bates-ville (formerly Old Augusta Road) being joined on all sides of property owned by Bonnie &. Smith and containing one-half (2) acre, more or less, and having the following courses and distances to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of the Old Augusta Road at the entrance of old driveway, thence sunning along said Drive Southward to an iron pin 207 feet; thence eastward 105 feet to an iron pin; thence Northward207 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Old Augusta Road; thence with said road 105 feet to the point of beginning. the same containing one-half acres, more or less.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute; that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
