NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of South Carolina Highway No. 14, and being shown as 1.03 acres, and the property immediately east and adjacent to said 1.03 acre tract on a Plat of property of R.C. Ayers by C. O. Riddle, dated June 1962, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WW, at page 327, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of South Carolina Highway No. 14, at the corner of property conveyed by the mortgagor to Wade Brown, Sr., which point is S. 6-00 E. 73 feet from the old corner of property of Wade Brown, Sr. as shown on said plat, and running thence along the center of said highway, S. 6-00 E. 179 feet; thence N. 83-36 E. 505.3 feet to an iron pin on the line of the J.
