MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Ladson Delmus Tankersley, of Greenville County,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate. lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 158 of a subdivision known as Lake Forest, Section III and having, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG at Page 77, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Rockmont Road, joint front corner of Lots 157 and 158; thence N. 34-58 W. 150.6 feet to a point where the joint line of Lots 157 and 158 intersect the high water line of Lake Fairfield; thence along the high water line of Lake Fairfield, the traverse line being S. 53-02 W. 171.7 feet to the intersection of Lots 158 and 159; thence N. 29-39 E. 226 feet to the corner of Lots 158 and 159 on the northern side of Rockmont Road; thence with the northern side of Rockmont Road, following the curvature thereof, the following courses and distances: N. 27-51 E. 170.4 feet and N. 50-48 E. 40.5 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Bernice C. Cashion by deed dated November 23, 1962 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 711 at Page 250."
