BEGINNING at a point on Old Augusta Road and running thence along Old Augusta Road S. 24-09 W., 200.8 feet to a point; thence running N. 75-02 W., 220 feet to a point; thence running N. 11-04 W., 282.4 feet to a point; thence running N. 66-36 W., 379.9 feet to the point of beginning.
