"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, shown as Lot 209 on plat of Belle Meade, made by Piedmont Engineering Services in June 1954, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, Page 117, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Pine Creek Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 210 and 209, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 12-49 E. 155.4 feet to a point on Brushy Creek; thence N. 11-29 W. 79.7 feet to a point on Brushy Creek Drive at the joint rear corner of Lots 208 and 209; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 11-18 W. 163.2 feet to an iron pin on Pine Creek Drive; thence along Pine Creek Drive, S. 77-03 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
