Soldo to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. Crunty of Greenville, Greenville Township, about two miles west of the Greenville County Courthouse and known and designated as Lot No. 44 as shown by reference to that certain plat of property designated City View; said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A, at Page 460 and 461; said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on the eastern side of Henderson Street with a depth of 150 feet to a ten-foot alley.

This being the same property conveyed to Rush H. Trammell and Lewis C. Black as will appear by reference to that certain deed recorded in the R.M.C.
