SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said John L. Baker and Virginia P. Baker
 in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, etc. well
 and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of
 Seven Thousand and No/100 ----- (\$ 7,000.00) Dollars
 with interest from the date hereof at the rate of nine per cent (9 %) per annum, unpaid interest to
 bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of Seventy-one and No/100 -----

----- (\$ 71.00) Dollars
 due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest
 and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments
 to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any,
 incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder
 shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of
 said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall in
 the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable
 attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible
 as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected
 by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the said John L. Baker and
 Virginia P. Baker, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money
 aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION,
 Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00)
 Dollars to the said mortgagee, are in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagor, at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained,
 sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND
 LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter
 constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs
 Township, located on the West side of Miller Drive and corner and designated as
 Lot number FIVE (5) on plat of property entitled "FLEMING HEIGHTS", made by Robert
 Jordan, surveyor, dated September 27, 1957 and recorded in plat book "32" page 113,
 Greenville County P. M. C. Office, and having the following corners and dimensions, to
 wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Miller Drive at the joint front
 corner of lots 4 and 5 and running thence S. 66-08 W., 217 feet to the common line of
 said lots to an iron pin; thence N. 26-00 W., 129.2 feet along property formerly of S. F.
 Flynn Estate to an iron pin at the rear corner of lot No. 6; thence N. 73-26 E.,
 230.2 feet along the line of lot No. 6 to pin on West side of Miller Drive; thence
 with the West side of Miller Drive S. 16-07 E., 27.5 feet thence still with the West
 side of Miller Drive, S. 20-32 E., 82.1 feet to the beginning corner. This is the
 same conveyed to James Edward Fleming by deed recorded in Deed Book 780 page 2,
 Greenville County P. M. C. Office, willed to Elsie Dillard Fleming by J. E. Fleming,
 estate in Apt. 600 File 12, Greenville County Probate Office and willed to Inezette
