MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE COUNTY OF..... GREENVILLE To All Whom These Presents May Concern: -DEVENGER ROAD LAND COMPANY ... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS: WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of TWENTY THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND NO/100----- (\$ 20,800.00_) Obollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of One Hundred Sixty-seven & 37/100---- (\$ 167.37 month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 30 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortzagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holler shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby acknowledged, his granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bing and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the west side of Brantford Lane, known and designated as Lot No. 71, as shown on a plat of the subdivision of South Forest Estates, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG at Page 181, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Brantford Lane, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 71 and 72 and running thence with the line of same, S. 84-41 W., 126.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 71, N. 7-54 W., 80.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 71 and 70; thence with the line of said lots, N. 84-41 E., 129.8 feet to an iron pin in the southeastern side of Brantford Lane; thence with the southeastern side of said Lane, S. 5-19 E., 81 feet to point and place of beginning.
