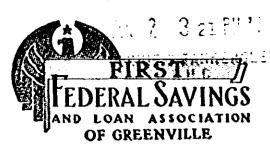

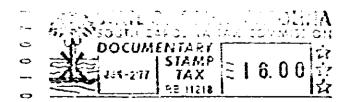

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, hing and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 15 on a plat of Pine Brook Forest Subdivision according to a plat prepared by Charles K. Dunn, Surveyor, said plat being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 4X, at pages 48 and 49, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Cannon Circle, joint front corner of Lots No. 15 and 16 and running thence along said lots S. 39-35 E. 212 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running along rear line of Lot No. 15 and property now or formerly of Chester Johnson, S. 73-25 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running along common line of Lots No. 15 and 16 N. 25-41 W. 158 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots No. 15 and 16 on the southern side of Cannon Circle; thence with the southern side of Cannon Circle N. 50-25 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
