"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northeastern side of Huntington Road, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot No. 30A as shown on a plat of Sheet No. 1 of Huntington Subdivision, prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated May 4, 1968, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
