WHEREAS said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any februe to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole anomal due the reinder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, located on the Western side of Eastland Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 and the adjoining 5 feet of Lot No. 4, Block A on a plat of Carolina Court as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 96 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Eastland Drive, said pin being 260 feet north of Laurens Road and running thence N. 55-45 W. 187.3 feet, more or less, to a stake in line of property now or formerly of Holcombe; thence N. 38-35 E. 70.15  $\mathfrak{R}$ feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 6 on said plat; thence S. 55-45 E. 185 feet to a point on Eastland Drive; thence along said drive S. 36-13 W. 70 feet to a stake, the point of beginning.
