of Greenville County, South Carolina . hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings: WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto THE SOUTH CAROLINA NATIONAL BANK

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of The United States of America , hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of THIRTY ONE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED and No/100----- Dollars (\$ 31,300.00), with interest from date at the rate TEN----per centum (10 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The South Carolina National Bank, Post Office in Columbia, South Carolina, 29202 or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY FOUR and 81/100----- Dollars (\$ 274.81 . 19 79 and on the first day of each month thereafter until August commencing on the first day of the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 2009.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Woodland Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 in accordance with plat made for Leake & Garrett, dated February, 1958, by Jones & Southerlin, and being further shown on a more recent plat by Freeland & Associates, dated June 25, 1979, entitled "Property of Ronald C. Cauble and Lynda J. Cauble," recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 7-H at Page 64, and having, according to said latter plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 on the eastern side of Woodland Drive, being 235+ feet from the intersection of Woodland Drive and Whatley Circle, and running thence S. 54-54 E. 172.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-13 W. 88 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 54-54 W. 172.1 feet to an iron pin on Woodland Drive; thence along Woodland Drive, N. 35-06 E. 88 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by deed of Timothy J. Nelson and Debra Sue Nelson, dated June 27, 1979, and recorded simultaneously herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided. Privilege is reserved to pay the debt in whole, or in an amount equal to one or more monthly payments on the principal that are next due on the note, on the first day of any month prior to maturity; provided, however, that written notice of an intention to exercise such privilege is given at least thirty (30) days prior to prepayment.

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
