) Dollars each on the first day of each monthly month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable. One year after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may bereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose:

That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, and account the following described and release to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwestern side of Hackney Road being shown as Lot No. 51 on a plat of River Downs Subdivision, dated July 1974, prepared by Piedmont Engineers, Architects & Planners, recorded in Plat Book 4-R at page 76 in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Hackney Road at the joint front corner of Lot 51 and Lot 52 and running thence with Lot 52 N 36-55 W 160 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 51 and Lot 52; thence N 45-14 E 158.27 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 50 and Lot 51; thence with Lot 50 S 47-53 E 170 feet to an iron pin on Hackney Road; thence with said road S 43-30 W 45 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said road S 49 W 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said road S 53 W 45 feet to the point of beginning.
