Isaah Kirksey subsequently conveyed all of his interest in said property to his son, Horace Dillard, by deed dated July 17, 1967, placing in the said Horace Dillard the entire ownership of the property. Horace Dillard died testate on June 6, 1970, bequeathing this property to his wife, Viola Dillard, reference Apartment 36, File 9, Probate Court for Greenville County. Viola Dillard died testate on June 20, 1974, leaving as her sole heir, Relave McIntyre, who is now the current and full owner of the property.
