BEGINNING at a stake on head waters of branch and running thence S. 62 E. 4.86 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 77-1/2 E. 7.40 chains to an iron pin; N. 6 W. 17.8 chains to a stone; thence N. 67 W. 1.15 chains to a small pine; thence N. 63 W. 1.72 chains to a pine; thence N. 75½ W. 3.85 chains to a stone; thence N. 83 W. 3.03 chains to a corner, Black Fork; thence S. 10 E. 3.75 chains with Roe and Howard land; thence S. 8 W. 8.82 chains to a sweet gum on branch; thence with the meanders of the branch S. 9½ E. 1.50 chains; thence with branch S. 1 E. 4.50 chains to the intersection of two branches; thence S. 9 W. 1.12 chains to a poplar, the beginning, and containing 20.45 acres, more or less.
