BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Gridley Street at the corner of lot heretofore conveyed by D.B. Tripp, and being more particularly described according to a plat prepared by W.J. Riddle, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

AND the mortgagor does hereby bind himself and his heirs and successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the infortgagee, its/his successors, heirs and assigns, from and against himself and his heirs and successors, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part Abereof.

i AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties that the mortgagor, his heirs and successors and assigns, shall keep any building erected on the premises insured against loss and damage by fire for the benefit of the mortgagee, for an amount and with such company as shall be approved by the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs and assigns, and shall deliver the policy to the mortgagee; and in default thereof, the mortgagee, its/his successors, heirs of assigns may, but have no duty to, effect such insurance and reimburse themselves under this mortgage for the expense thereof, together with interest thereon at the rate provided in the note from the date of its payment. And it is further agreed, in the event of other insurance and contribution between the insurance monies to be paid a sum equal to the amount of the debt secured by this mortgage.

AND IT IS AGREED, that if all or any part of the Property or an interest therein is sold or transferred by Mortgagor without Mortgagee's prior written Consent, excluding (a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Mortgage. (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for appusehold appliances. (c) a transfer by devise, descent or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of the purchase of the series of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be the person of the series of the sum of the series of transfer. Mortgage and payable and Mortgagee may forcelose this Mortgage accordingly. Mortgagee shall have waived such option to accelerate if, prior to the sale or transfer. Mortgagee and the person to whom the Property is to be sold or transferred reach agreement in writing that the credit of such person is the sale or transfer. Mortgagee and that the interest payable on the sums secured by this Mortgage shall be at such rate as Mortgagee shall request. If Mortgagee waived the option to accelerate provided in this paragraph, and if Mortgagor's successor in interest has executed a written assumption agreement of this Mortgagee. AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties, that if the mortgagor, his heirs and successors or assigns, shall fail to pay all taxes and assessments upon the premise when they shall first become payable, then the mortgagee, its his successors, heirs or assigns, may cause the same to be paid, together with all penalties and costs incurred thereon, and reimburse themselves under this mortgage for the sum so paid, with interest thereon at the rate provided in the note from the date of such payment.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties that upon any default being made in the payment of the note or of the insurance premiums, or of the taxes, or of the assessments hereinabove mentioned, or failure to pay any other indebtedness which constitutes a lien upon the real property when the same shall severally become payable, then the entire amount of the debt secured or intended to be secured hereby shall become due, at the option of the mortgagee, its his successors, heirs or assigns, although the period for the payment thereof may not then have expired.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties that should legal proceedings be instituted for the collection of the debt secured hereby, then the mortgagee, its his successors, heirs or assigns, shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents and profits of the premises, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings, and the execution of the trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents and profits towards the payment of the debt secured hereby.
