KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Jackson Green

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

C.P. Robison (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
C.P. Robison, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated in the County and State aforesaid
in the Town of Greer; having the following particular description:

Beginning at a point on an un-named Street and runs; thence with said Street One hundred and ten
(110) to T.B. Snows line; thence with his line One hundred and fifty feet (150) to a point;
thence with another line of T.B. Snows one hundred and ten feet (110) to a point; thence at
right angles one hundred and fifty feet (150) to the beginning corner and being the same lot of
land conveyed to me by A.A. Fowler in deed bearing date August 30th, 1909.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
C.P. Robison, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said C.P. Robison, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same, or any part thereof.
