KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, D.L. Jones of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.P. Jones of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W.P. Jones, all that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in the Town of Simpsonville, adjoining lands of said W.P. Jones, being a small triangular piece of land fronting twenty-one feet on the Old Greenville Road and below a proposed new Street 24 feet wide and running back to nothing on lower side of said Street.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W.P. Jones, and his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W.P. Jones, and his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
