to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.F. Freeman and D.R. Freeman, known by the firm name of J.F. Freeman & Bro. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.F. Freeman & Bro. All that tract of land situated, lying and being in said State and County, Butler Township on Brushy Creek, adjoining lands of Ed. F. Raines, James N. Hudson and others being lot No. 6 of the said T.L. Freeman Estate, having the following metes and bounds, Viz: Beginning on a stone on the West side of the said Brushy Creek below the bridge running; thence S. 52 W. 6.98 chains to a stone on the Old Spartanburg Road; thence S. 53 1/4 E. 8.90 chains to a stone; thence S. 52 3/4 W. 8.53 chains to a stone; thence S. 12 1/2 W. 15.45 chains to a stone; thence S. 35 3/4 E. 28.53 chains to a stone near a school house; thence N. 7 W. 20.60 chains to iron pin; thence N. 39 E. 15.73 chains to iron pin; thence N. 19 1/4 W. 10.13 chains to a poplar 3XNM; thence N. 18 1/2 W. 4.53 chains to a sweet-gum on the South side of the said Brushy-Creek; thence up the said Brushy Creek as the line about 15.25 chains to the beginning corners, containing sixty-three and three-fourths, - more or less.
