in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Jane Hallman (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Jane Hallman, all that certain lot of land known as Lot No. 4 in Block P. Park Place,

having the following metes and bounds to wit:
Fronting 50 ft. on Third Avenue, facing East & running back on North side 150 ft. on the
South side 148 ft. to an alley, as shown in a revised plat on file in the office of R.M.C.
for Greenville County in Plat Book A. page 119 & being the same conveyed to me by W.W. Putman
on the 29th, of Nov. 1909.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Jane Hallman, and her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
