KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.L. Poole of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.H. Poole (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W.H. Poole, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and in Saluda Township, State aforesaid on some branch waters of South Tyger River, being part of a tract of land granted to Jeremiah Trammell Oct. 15, 1854.

Also a piece of land conveyed to the said Jeremiah Trammell by the Sheriff of Greenville County and sold as the property of Alexander McKinney and runs as follows:

Beginning on a chestnut oak 3X, running; thence N. $73\frac{1}{2}$ W. 13.95 ch. to a black gum 3X; thence S. $36\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.30 ch. to a stone 3X; thence S. $87\frac{1}{2}$ E. 22.25 ch. to a stone 3X; thence S. $18\frac{1}{4}$ W. 11.63 ch. to a sour-wood 3X (down); thence S. $87\frac{1}{2}$ E. 36.30 ch. to a stake 3X; thence N. 9 W. 19.50 ch. to a stake 3X in the branch; thence up the meanders of said branch 34.00 ch. to a stake 3X in the branch on Wm. Turners line (now the line of Arkie Turner); thence S. 27 W. 8.45 ch. to the beginning chestnut oak- 3X, containing 85 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of J.P. Pitman, Arkie Turner and Dorthula Newman, being the same lands conveyed to B.L. Still by Nancy E. Poole, Sept. 1st, 1904 and is the same deeded to me by B.L. Still the 12th, day of August 1909.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said

W.H. Poole, his

heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W.H. Poole, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
