in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. A. Thomason, all that piece, parcel and lot of land lying in the Town of Fountain Inn, County and State above named, and having the following courses and distances to wit:

Beginning at a corner and extending N. 31 E. 6.34; thence N. 59 W. 1.58; thence S. 31 W. 6.34; thence S. 59 E. 1.58 to beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less, and being bounded on the West by Main Street.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
