(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Thomas T. Goldsmith, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, and County of Greenville and being a portion of The Rowley Place and having the following metes and bounds:

Commencing at a stake on McGee Street, joint corners of Lots Nos. 45 and 46 and running; thence N. 21° 45' W. one hundred fifty-two feet and six inches to a stake on East Ave.; thence with East Ave. S. 80° 0' W. one hundred and fifty five feet to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence along line of said Alley S 21° 45' E. one hundred and fifty seven feet and six inches to a stake joint corners of lots Nos. 45 and 46; thence along joint lines of said lots in a Northeasternly direction, one hundred and fifty-five feet to a stake at the beginning corner, same being lots Nos. 46, 47 and 48, according to a survey made by W.A. Adams, January 1910.

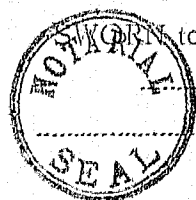
