Emma E. Bramlett (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Bramlett All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on waters of Wiers Creek, waters of North Saluda River and in Saluda Township and has the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone corner of Wm. Turners; thence N. 25-1/2 W. 13.32 ch. to a stone; thence N. 52 W. 2.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 86 W. 51.26 ch. to a stone; thence S. 2 E. 19.90 ch. to a stone; thence N. 80-1/2 E. 59.74 ch. to the beginning corner, containing (97) ninety-seven acres, more or less., adjoining lands of Wm. Turner, Hattie Speegle and others.
