acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Oscar Murray, all that piece or parcel of land lying and being in the 1st, Ward of the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being a part of the lot of land sold me by W.H. Irvine, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. County of Greenville, Vol. 9, Page 492 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

Commencing at an iron pin on the S.W. Cor. of said lot and running; thence N. 33-E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57 E. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35- W 100 feet, 6 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 46 W, 58 feet to the beginning corner. It is understood and agreed that this deed includes a right of way from Buckner Alley to the lot herein described.

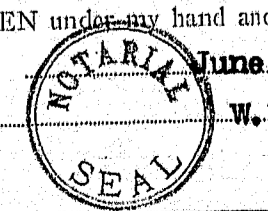

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Tom Harrison

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Tom Harrison, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Johnson Street, about two hundred and eight feet from the east side of Westfield Street at the corner of lot No. 3, on plat made by J.M. Cureton, and filed in Judgement Roll A.-2506, and running; thence with line of said Lot No. 3, N. 10-1/2 E. eighty-two feet to a stake on an alley; thence with said Alley S. 89-1/2 W. five feet to a stake; thence continuing with said alley N. 68-3/4 W. about forty-one feet to a stake; thence S. 10-1/2 W. eighty-two feet to a stake on Johnson Street and thence with Johnson Street forty-five feet to the beginning.
