

J. Edward Earle DEED TO Dunean Mills

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Edwards Earle, of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five thousand six hundred and eighty DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Dunean Mills, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Dunean Mills, that certain tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid about 2-1/2 miles from the City of Greenville on the Columbia & Greenville Railroad, containing one hundred and two and seventy-two hundredths (102.72) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in line of land formerly belonging to Martha Kane, thirty (30) feet from the center of the main line of the Columbia & Greenville Railroad; thence along course thirty (30) feet from the center of said railroad as follows: S. 10.02 W. one hundred and seventeen (117) feet to stake; thence S. 10.49 W. two hundred and three (203) feet to stake; thence S. 14.17 W. two hundred and two (202) feet to stake; thence S. 18.37 W. one hundred and ninety-nine (199) feet to stake; thence S. 22.42 W. two hundred and four (204) feet to stake; thence S. 26.07 W. two hundred (200) feet to stake; thence S. 30.27 W. one hundred and ninety-eight (198) feet to stake; thence S. 33.37 W. one hundred and twenty-seven (127) feet to stake; thence S. 34 W. two hundred and twenty (220) feet to stake in line of Anna Bynum; thence along line almost perpendicular to said railroad with line of Anna Bynum and Melrose Land Company S. 56.39 E. eleven hundred and fifty-three (1153) feet to iron pin by stone, old corner; thence S. 26.23 W. four hundred and thirty (430) feet to iron pin by stone, old corner of W.A.
