is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. L. Tase, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that lot of land, in Ward Five in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County in the State of South Carolina, as having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake corner of Pendleton and Anderson Streets at the corner of lot of J. L. Tase, thence along Anderson Street S. 35° W. 82 ft to corner of lot of J. L.
