THIS CONTRACT made and entered into this 7th day of July 1910, between F.D. Hunter and Enoree .

Power Company. WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

The said F.D. Hunter for and in consideration of the sum of \$\\$\\$\ Five & no/100 in hand paid by the said Encree Power Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant unto the said Encree Power Company, its successors or assigns, the right and privilege to raise a dam on their shoals on Encree River to such height as they or their successors or assigns may desire. It is further agreed as part of this contract that should, after the raising of such dam, the lands of the said F.D. Hunter living in Laurence & Greenville County's become in any way injured or damaged by the water from backing by such dam as said Power Company may raise on said stream, the said Encree Power Company hereby binds itself, its successors or assigns, to pay the amount of such damage to the said F.D. Hunter heirs, executors, administrators or assigns. The amount of such damage, in case the parties hereto cannot agree upon the same, shall be arrived at and fixed in the following manner, to-wit:

The said F.D. Hunter heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, is to select one arbitrator, and the said Encree Power Company to select another, and these two arbitrators to select a third; if these two cannot agree upon such third arbitrator then he is to be selected by Clerk of Court; and if he will not make such selection, then such selection to be made by Probate Judge; and if he will not, then by Sheriff; and if for any reason arbitrators cannot be chosen, or a majority of them cannot agree, then the amount of such damage is to be determined by action of law.

The award of said arbitrators shall be final and conclusive in determining the amount of the said damage.
