WHEREAS, the Enoree Power Company, a duly organized corporation, proposes to transmit power by electricity from its power plant to such points as may be deemed advisable, and to construct such lines as may be necessary for said purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J.E. Walker of said County and State, in consideration of the premises and the sum of Two Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Enoree Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, released and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and convey, unto the said Enoree Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of J.A. Cannon, C. & W.C. R.R. and others and to construct and maintain in, upon, along and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires, conduits and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line or lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity aforesaid, and also to construct and maintain in, along and through the said premises with poles, wires, etc., a telephone line or lines, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

Actual damage done to crops in future to be paid by said Company provided within claim be presented within sixty days after the act causing such damages.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the rights, privileges and easements as aforesaid in, to and upon said premises, unto the said Enoree Power Company, its successors and assigns.
