Dillard, deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of six thousand and sixty (\$6,060.00) Dollars to me in hand paid by the said H.L. Dillard, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) and in pursuance of the power vested in me under and by said Will, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said H.L. Dillard, that certain tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid being a part of the Home Place of the said M.G. Dillard, deceased, containing one hundred and one (101) acres, more or less, designated on plat made by W.D. Neves, Engineer, in May, 1912, as tract No. 3, and as having the following metes and bounds, to wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the Greer and Pelham Road, and running thence S. 53 W. 13,50 to a Pine 3X; thence S. 83.30 W. 34.50 to an ash 3X; on the east bank of Enorse River; thence down the meanders of said River, to a stone, Minnie Dillard's corner; thence S. 80.40 E. 1.75 along said Dillard's line to stone; thence S. 9.15 E. along said Dillard's line, 5.60 to stone; thence N. 79 E. 36.80 along said Dillard's land, to stone; thence N. 77.30 E. 13.70 to the Greer and Pelham Road; thence up center of said Road to the beginning point.
